

EDP is now part of Dow Jones Sustainable Index

EDP was integrated in Dow Jones Sustainability Index Euro Stoxx (DJSI), the most demanding sustainability stock index in Europe and in the world. The DJSI measures the financial performance of leading Eurozone companies as measured by their sustainability and environmental practices. The stock universe is the Dow Jones STOXX Sustainability Index, from which only companies operating in Eurozone nations (countries that have transitioned to the Euro) are chosen. The index distinguishes companies that, in each sector of activity, present best performance on social and environmental areas while maintaining transparent financial processes and management quality. In the utilities sector, only 7 companies are currently listed in this index. This recognition illustrates EDP's commitment to a more sustainable future.

EDP proved its commitment to climate change and sustainable growth when purchasing Horizon Wind Energy from Goldman Sachs in July 2007 for nearly \$3 billion. EDP again demonstrated its confidence in the renewables sector by raising over \$2 billion and holding an initial public offering (IPO) of 22.5 percent of its renewable energy business, EDP Renováveis (EDPR), on June 4th.

Based in Houston, Texas Horizon has developed more than 2,000 megawatts (MW) and owns over 1,300 MW of operating wind farms. Horizon is currently developing a portfolio of more than 11,000 MW in over 15 states, more than enough to provide energy to 2.5 million homes in the United States. Horizon is owned by EDP Renováveis. EDP Renováveis is a leading renewable energy company that designs, develops, manages and operates power plants that generate electricity using renewable energy sources, mainly wind energy.
