

Horizon Wind Energy CEO Featured at Global Power Conference Antonio Martins da Costa Speaks on Carbon, Growth and Challenge

LAS VEGAS, NEVADA (April 15, 2008) - Antonio Martins da Costa, Chief Executive Officer of Horizon Wind Energy, owned by Energias de Portugal (EDP), was a keynote speaker at the Platts 23rd Annual Global Power Markets Conference in Las Vegas at The Wynn hotel on Monday, April 14, 2008.
